DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES

<u>Mesquite</u> (Mesquite) 972-270-7457; 827 North Hwy 67. Drive the George Bush Turnpike east/south. It ends at I-30. Exit right (East) towards Dallas. Drive 2 miles, exit at Belt Line Rd and stay on the service road. Continue on service road, .9 miles past the traffic light. Course entrance on right.

<u>Heritage Ranch C.C.</u> (Fairview) 972-549-0276; 465 Scenic Ranch Circle. Take I-75 (Central Expwy) north, exit at Stacy Rd., right turn (east) 3 miles to the dead end (FM 1378). Turn left, then an immediate right, back onto Stacy Rd. Continue east for ½ mile, course entrance on left (has gate guard).

<u>Hurricane Creek C.C.</u> (Anna) 972-924-3247; 1800 Fairway Lane. Take I-75 (Central Expwy) north, exit at Anna (Truck Stop), turn left go over I-75, right turn onto the west service road, drive 1.7 miles (north). Left turn at small sign, leads to club.

<u>Tangleridge</u> (Grand Prairie) 972-299-6837; 818 Tangle Ridge Dr. Take I-35E south thru downtown Dallas. Bear right at the Hwy 67 split, towards Cleburne. After passing under I-20, drive 8.7 miles, exit at Lake Ridge Pkwy., right turn (2 miles). Turn left at Park Ridge Dr., follow signs through residential area to golf course.

<u>Bridlewood</u> (Flower Mound) 972-355-4800; 4000 W. Windsor Dr. Proceed north on I-35E, exit at FM1171/Main St. (Lewisville). Turn left (west), drive 5 ½ miles, right turn at Bridlewood Blvd. At 1st stop sign, turn right, course entrance on left.

<u>Hackberry Creek C.C.</u> (Irving) 972-869-2631; 1901 W. Royal Ln. Drive the George Bush Turnpike (west/south). Take the 1st exit after passing over the LBJ Frwy (Royal Lane/Hwy 114/Gateway Dr.) After exiting, make a quick right turn onto the street that has a small sign that reads Royal Lane, just prior to new construction. Turn right and follow the road to the stop sign, then turn right again. Drive .2 mile, course entrance on right.

RULE REMINDER---

USGA has specific rules for lateral hazards and water hazards, however, NTSGA treats both the red stakes and yellow stakes the same to simplify the rules and to keep play moving. If you hit your ball into a hazard you may play it as it lies, without grounding your club – <u>No Penalty</u>. Or you may lift the ball out of the hazard and drop the ball within 2 club lengths of where it entered the hazard, no closer to the hole, <u>Penalty 1 stroke</u>. Or you may proceed back as far as desired on the line from where you hit the errant shot, <u>Penalty 1 stroke</u>.
