

DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES...

Oct. 4 <u>Frisco Lakes</u> (Flower Mound) 972-292-3089; 899 Rose Lane. Take the Dallas No. Tollway north of Hwy 121, exit at Lebanon, turn left (west) for approx. 4.5 miles to FM 423. Turn right for approx. 1.1 miles to Stonebrook Pkwy (2nd traffic light). Turn left (west) for 1.3 miles. Turn left at Anthem Dr., leads to clubhouse.

Oct. 11 <u>Hurricane Creek C.C.</u> (Anna) 972-924-3247; 1800 Fairway Lane. Take I-75 (Central Expwy) north, exit at Anna (Truck Stop), turn left go over I-75, right turn onto the west side service road (Caution: Exiting traffic from southbound I-75 has right of way). Drive 1.7 miles (north). Left turn at small sign, leads to club.

Oct. 18 <u>Heritage Ranch C.C.</u> (Fairview) 972-549-0276; 465 Scenic Ranch Circle. Take I-75 (Central Expwy) north, exit at Stacy Rd., right turn (east) 3 miles to the dead end (FM 1378). Turn left, then an immediate right, back onto Stacy Rd. Continue east for ½ mile, course entrance on left.

Oct. 25 <u>Tangleridge</u> (Grand Prairie) 972-299-6837; 818 Tangle Ridge Dr. Take I-35E south thru downtown Dallas. Bear right at the Hwy 67 split, towards Cleburne. After passing under I-20, drive 8.7 miles, exit at Lake Ridge Pkwy., right turn (2 miles). Turn left at Park Ridge Dr., follow signs through residential area to golf course. Or, drive south on the George Bush Turnpike through Arlington towards I-20. Exit at Lake Ridge Parkway (the exit before I-20) and continue south for approx 8.5 miles. Still on Lake Ridge Pkwy., turn right at entrance to the Tangleridge housing area. Drive approx. 1.2 miles (past elementary school). Turn right at Park Ridge Ct. (Leads to golf course).

Nov.1 <u>Waterchase</u> (Arlington) 817-861-4653; 8951 Creek Run Rd. Take I-30 westbound, past the Rangers Ballpark, exit at Eastchase Pkwy., right turn to 2nd traffic light. (John T. White Rd.) Turn right for 1 block. Right turn at Randol Mill Rd., go ¼ mile, left turn at Creek Run Rd., (alongside apt. complex), course ½ mile on left.

NTSGA RULES REFRESHER.....OUT OF BOUNDS

A ball hit out of bounds (defined by white stakes) may be brought back into play at the point where it last crossed the out of bounds line. You may play your next shot within 2 club lengths of the spot the ball crossed the out of bounds line or anywhere on a straight line from where it crossed the out of bounds boundary back to where you hit the errant shot. Penalty: 1 Stroke. You cannot use the 1 club rule to move a ball that is out of bounds, back in-bounds. Any time a ball is out of bounds, the golfer incurs a 1 stroke penalty.
