#### SIGN-UP POLICY:

Tournament Sign-Up Policy. Email and telephone sign-ups start at 8:00AM, 8 days prior to an event and stop at 12:00 noon, 2 days before an event. Players who sign-up and fail to show-up, may incur a 2 event suspension and be placed at the top of the random drop list, regardless of any previous drop. Note: a no show is defined as not giving notification by the 12:00 noon deadline, 2 days before an event without due cause. This suspension can be prevented by notifying the Tournament Chairman (972-699-0644) prior to 12:00 noon, 2 days prior to an event. After 3 sign-up/no-shows a players' NTSGA membership will be terminated. Last minute no-shows can be avoided by contacting the golf course; they will relay a message to Rod. #### **RULE CHANGES FOR 2019**

- 1) When needed to take a drop from an errant shot or ground under repair, the ball shall be dropped from knee height in the relief area.
- 2) <u>Three minutes</u> is the maximum time to search for a ball. (Always has been per NTSGA Rules of Tournament Play).
- 3) Spike marks or any other damage to the putting surface, may now be repaired without penalty.
- 4) If a putt hits the flagstick while it is still in the hole, there is no penalty.
- 5) You may ground your club and move loose impediments in all hazard areas except a bunker.
