DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES

<u>Firewheel-Bridges</u> (Garland) 972-205-2795; 1535 Brand Rd. Take Geo Bush Turnpike east, exit at Brand Rd., turn left (north) 1 mile, course entrance on left.

Cedar Crest (Dallas) 214-670-7615; 1800 Southerland Ave. Take I-35 south through downtown Dallas, past the Dallas Zoo. Exit at Illinois Ave. Turn left (east) for 1 ½ miles, cross Corinth/Lancaster Rd., turn left at next street (Belknap). It becomes Southerland and leads to golf course, on right.

<u>Hurricane Creek C.C.</u> (Anna) 972-924-3247; 1800 Fairway Lane. Take I-75 (Central Expwy) north, exit at Anna (Truck Stop), turn left go over I-75, right turn onto the west side service road (Caution: Exiting traffic from southbound I-75 has right of way). Drive 1.7 miles (north). Left turn at small sign, leads to club.

WestRidge (McKinney) 972-346-2212; 9055 Cotton Ridge Road North. Take I-75 north to McKinney, exit at Virginia Pkwy. Turn left (west) and drive 5.5 miles to Custer Rd. (FM 2478); turn left (south) for ½ mile, course entrance on right.

NTSGA TOURNAMENT CHANGES FOR 2018:

Recently, the Board of Directors made a change to our golf tournaments that will take effect with the beginning tournament in January:

- 1) Regardless of age or handicap, you may opt to play from the forward tees during 2018. This option may be exercised at any time during the year, but once the move is made, the golfer must remain playing the forward tees for the remainder of the year. This decision must be made known to **Handicap Chairman, Howie Bacharach** at hbacharach@aol.com or 410-507-2932 before competing in your first tournament of 2018. If you do not intend to change tee boxes from 2017....no need to contact **Howie.**
- 2) Special Tournaments:
 - The recent survey indicated that members occasionally enjoy a different tournament format from our usual stroke play events. This includes mixing the foursomes allowing longtime members to become acquainted with many new members. We will continue to hold the WestRidge Shamble as we have for several years and will add one additional special event during 2018. This will be a tournament organized and planned by 3 NTSGA volunteer members giving Tournament Chairman, **Rod Wells** a break from his weekly tournament duties. These volunteers will make the pairings, distribute the rules sheet and assign starting holes. 

HANDICAPS....

Handicap computations now fall more closely in line with USGA standards. Handicap Chairman, **Howie Bacharach** will compute handicaps twice monthly in hopes of greater stabilization of individual handicaps. You will receive an "NTSGA Index" determined by the lowest 10 out of your last 20 gross scores, adjusted for the course and slope rating of the tees you played and factored by 0.96. This new "NTSGA Index" is very similar to GHIN or a similar service, which creates an average handicap index based on all courses and tees that you played.

To comply with USGA Handicap Manual Sect. 3-5a for each round, players will have their "NTSGA Index" **adjusted** to the course and tee they are playing **during that round**. Your **adjusted index** will be used to calculate your net score, which determines flight winners. This allows players playing from different tees to compete for the same prizes.
