DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES...

Sept. 5 <u>WestRidge</u> (McKinney) 972-346-2212; 9055 Cotton Ridge Road North. Take I-75 (Central Expy) north to McKinney, exit at Virginia Pkwy. Turn left (west) and drive 5.5 miles to Custer Rd. (FM 2478); turn left (south) for ½ mile, course entrance on right.

Sept. 12 The Tribute (The Colony) 972-370-5465; 1000 Lebanon Rd. From Hwy 121 (Sam Rayburn Tollway) and Josey Ln./Main St./Hwy 423 drive north (through The Colony) for 4.1 miles. At Lebanon (stop light, Walgreens on left) turn left. Drive 3 miles through residential area (pass the Old American Golf Club on the left). At Dead End, turn right into The Tribute parking lot. Or, Drive north on the Dallas Tollway and exit at John Hickman Pkwy/Lebanon Rd. (north of the Sam Rayburn Tollway). At 2nd traffic light (Lebanon Rd.) turn left and drive 4.4 miles crossing Hwy 423. Drive another 3 miles through residential area. At dead end, turn right into course parking lot.

Sept. 25 <u>Indian Creek</u> (Carrollton) 972-466-9850; 1650 W. Frankford. Drive north on I-35E (Stemmons Frwy). Under the George Bush Turnpike flyover, exit at Frankford Rd. Follow the road as it turns right, drive .6 mile, course entrance on left.

Sept. 26 <u>Watters Creek</u> (Plano) 972-517-7777; 7201 Chase Oaks Blvd. Drive I-75 (Central Expwy). Exit at Legacy Dr., turn west. At 2nd traffic light, (Chase Oaks Blvd) turn right. Course ½ mile on left.



2018 PGA CHAMPIONSHIP POT

Bellerive C.C. in St. Louis was the site of the 100th PGA Championship. NTSGA members made their selections and to no surprise the favorite picks were Rickie Fowler, Dustin Johnson, Rory McIlroy, Justin Thomas and Jordan Spieth. Long hitting Gary Woodland led the field after Day 1, shooting a sparkling 64. Other golfers trying to stay close to the lead trailing by only 5

strokes included Rickie Fowler, Zach Johnson, Jason Day, Dustin Johnson, Justin Thomas and Brooks Koepka. Forty seven players were under par after Round 1 including Tiger Woods, Adam Scott, Justin Rose, Francesco Molinari, Tommy Fleetwood and Bubba Watson. Weather conditions were hot and humid with rain in the forecast.

First round leader, Gary Woodland had an early tee time on Day 2 and was able to complete his round before the rains came. The afternoon tee time golfers were unable to finish their rounds and would have to begin

Round 3 began early with the golfers unable to finish Friday's round and sadly some of the favorite selections of NTSGA members missed the cut including Phil Mickelson, Matt Kucher, Patrick Reed and Paul Casey. This took the luster off 9 NTSGA members as their selections were no longer in contention. Brooks Koepka seems to take charge of the major tournaments this year as he has already won the U.S. Open and now led the PGA Championship by 2 strokes at the completion of Saturday's round. There were 7 golfers chasing Koepka and all were within 4 strokes of the lead. Big names were thrilling the massive crowds sometime standing 10 deep to watch their favorite players. Tiger Woods was listening to ear deafening roars as his birdies electrified the crowd, clawing his way up the leaderboard. **Dennis Smith** and **Bob King** were rooting hard as both of them had Tiger as one-half of their combo picks.

Day 4 turned out to be a beautiful day for golf and the pros were taking dead aim at the pins in an attempt to overtake leader Brooks Koepka. Ten NTSGA members had selected Koepka, but who was going to be able to select the correct combination of finish? Adam Scott came out of nowhere and maintained 2nd position most of the day until being overtaken by Tiger Woods. **Dick Hall, Tom McMahan, Bill Lambert, Stan Robertson, Bill Kibler, Gene Edmondson** and **Jim Yarbrough** were pulling hard for their selections as the tournament came to a conclusion. Brooks Koepka won the PGA Championship by 2 strokes, but Tiger Woods found some old-time magic and had the huge crowd hanging on his every stroke. There was a 3-way tie for the winning combination: **Gene Edmondson, Tom McMahan** and **Stan Robertson** all selected Brooks Koepka (1) and Justin Thomas (T6).

CONGRATULATIONS, to these three members, all pocketing \$123.00. The next major pot will be the 2019 Masters, April 11-14.

SKINS SIGN-UP

It is <u>not</u> necessary to sign-up for skins participation, <u>online</u>. Decide which skins you would like to participate (Gross or Net) and pay the entry (\$10.00) as you pass through the check-in table at each tournament site.

ALTERNATE DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO GRAPEVINE G.C.

Drive west on LBJ freeway (I-635). Approaching the north end of DFW airport, take exit #36B. Stay in the left lane and follow signs for Hwy 121 North/Texas 2499. Then follow signs to Texas 2499 (Flower Mound). Drive several miles and after passing 2nd traffic light (Gernault Rd.) drive .8 mile and turn left at Lakeside Village Blvd./Silveron Blvd. (no traffic light). Drive .3 mile to roundabout. Enter roundabout and come out headed south. Drive .6 mile (go past the spillway). Course entrance on left at dead end.

These headings will appear in either Blue or Gray print. Click on the title you want to review and the complete computer sort appears. If you suspect an error or have a complaint, you must bring it to the attention of the Scoring Committee immediately, so it can be reviewed and rectified before the next event.
