#### **DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES**

Oct. 2 <u>Frisco Lakes</u> (Flower Mound) 972-292-3089; 899 Rose Lane. Take the Dallas No. Tollway north of Sam Rayburn Tollway (Hwy 121), exit at Stonebrook Pkwy, turn left (west) for approx. 4 miles. Drive straight across Main St. (Hwy 423) and drive another 1.2 miles. Turn left at golf course sign, entrance ¼ mile on left.

Oct. 9 <u>Hurricane Creek C.C.</u> (Anna) 972-924-3247; 1800 Fairway Lane. Take US-75 (Central Expwy) north, past the Anna Truck Stop. Take exit #49 (Mantua Rd.). At stop sign, turn left and drive over top of US-75. Turn left at the southside service road and proceed <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> mile. Turn right at small sign, leads to Golf Club.

Oct. 16 <u>Tangleridge</u> (Grand Prairie) 972-299-6837; 818 Tangle Ridge Dr. Take I-35E south thru downtown Dallas. Bear right at the Hwy 67 split, towards Cleburne. After passing under I-20, drive 8.7 miles, exit at Lake Ridge Pkwy., right turn, drive 2 miles. Turn left at Park Ridge Dr. (traffic light), follow signs through residential area for approx. 1.2 miles to golf course entrance. Or, drive south on the George Bush Turnpike through Arlington towards I-20. Exit at Lake Ridge Parkway (the exit before I-20) and continue south for approx 8.5 miles. After exiting <u>2<sup>nd</sup></u> bridge, drive .8 mile turning right at the traffic light to enter the Tangleridge housing area. Drive approx. 1.2 miles (go past elementary school). Turn right at Park Ridge Ct. (Leads to golf course).

Oct. 23 <u>Heritage Ranch C.C.</u> (Fairview) 972-549-0276; 465 Scenic Ranch Circle. Take US-75 (Central Expwy) north, exit at Stacy Rd., right turn (east) 3 miles to the dead end (FM 1378). Turn left, then an immediate right, back onto Stacy Rd. Continue east for ½ mile, course entrance on left (gated community with guard shack).

Oct. 30 <u>Waterchase</u> (Arlington) 817-861-4653; 8951 Creek Run Rd. Take I-30 westbound, past the Rangers Ballpark, exit at Eastchase Pkwy., right turn to 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light. (John T. White Rd.) Turn right for 1 block. Right turn at Randol Mill Rd., go ¼ mile, left turn at Creek Run Rd., (alongside apt. complex), course ½ mile on left.

#### PREVENTING SLOW PLAY

#### ...Randy Skinner

Aim to play in 20 seconds. From club selection to pre-shot routine to execution, strive to hit your shot in 20 seconds when it is your turn to play. Help keep play moving at a brisk pace!

#### CART FLAGS:

The issuance of cart flags to members with a legitimate personal handicap or short term illness came before the Board of Directors recently. After lengthy discussion, the Board decided that NTSGA should not get involved with this topic, but rather, it should be a decision made by the individual golf courses where we play. Speaking directly to the golf pro, he said they would be happy to accommodate a handicap golfer with a flag for his cart allowing him to drive closer to the green because of injury or short term illness, and would be reasonably accommodating to those golfers. The golfer would have to present a handicap placard (like the one that hangs from a rear view mirror) issued by the state of Texas, to the Pro Shop before the round. The handicap carts should **NEVER** be driven on the green or through the bunkers and cart flags would never be issued when the course has announced "Cart Path Only" for the round.
