### **DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES**

Mar. 2 <u>Luna Vista</u> (Dallas) 214-670-6322; 11223 Luna Rd. Drive to I-35E (Stemmons Frwy). Exit at Royal Lane. Drive west 1.1 miles (traffic light). Turn left (Luna Rd.), drive .4 mile, course entrance on right.

Mar. 9 <u>Tangleridge</u> (Grand Prairie) 972-299-6837; 818 Tangle Ridge Dr. Take I-35E south thru downtown Dallas. Bear right at the Hwy 67 split, towards Cleburne. After passing under I-20, drive 8.7 miles, exit at Lake Ridge Pkwy., right turn, drive 2 miles. Turn left at Park Ridge Dr. (traffic light), follow signs through residential area for approx. 1.2 miles to golf course entrance. Or, drive south on the George Bush Turnpike through Arlington towards I-20. Exit at Lake Ridge Parkway (the exit before I-20) and continue south for approx 8.5 miles. After exiting <u>2<sup>nd</sup></u> bridge, drive .8 mile turning right at the traffic light to enter the Tangleridge residential area. Drive approx. 1.2 miles (go past elementary school). Turn right at Park Ridge Ct. Leads to golf course.

Mar. 16 <u>Prairie Lakes</u> (Grand Prairie) 972-263-0661; 3202 SE 14<sup>th</sup> St. Drive I-35 southbound, take the Loop 12 split towards Irving. Drive approx. 10 miles south, then take Spur 408 for about 1½ miles and make a right turn onto Hwy 303 driving west over Mountain Creek Lake. On the other side of the lake, turn left @ SE 14<sup>th</sup> St. (traffic light). Course entrance approx. ½ mile on left.

Mar. 23 <u>Woodbridge</u> (Wylie) 972-429-5100 7400 Country Club Dr. Drive the Geo Bush Turnpike, exit at Hwy 78 (north) in Garland. Drive 3.9 miles; at traffic light turn right into the Woodbridge subdivision. At 2<sup>nd</sup> stop sign, turn left. Course entrance .2 miles, straight ahead.

Mar. 30 <u>Heritage Ranch</u> (Fairview) 972-549-0276; 465 Scenic Ranch Circle. Take US-75 (Central Expwy) north, exit at Stacy Rd., right turn (east) 3 miles to the dead end (FM 1378). Turn left, then an immediate right, back onto Stacy Rd. Continue east for ½ mile, course entrance on left (gated community with guard shack).

# NTSGA RULES REFRESHER: BUNKER PLAY

A ball hit into a bunker must be played as it lies. Incidental touching of the sand is permitted. The ball may <u>not</u> be moved, unless it rests in a human or animal footprint, mud, water or an abnormal condition created by maintenance equipment. If a ball rests in wet sand and the bunker has areas of dry sand, the ball may be lifted, dry sand raked and the ball <u>dropped</u> in the raked sand. Loose impediments may be removed. If there are <u>no dry areas</u> in the bunker, <u>drop</u> the ball on the tee side of the bunker within one club length from the front edge of the bunker. There is no penalty. The bunker should be between the player and the green. A ball may be lifted any time from a bunker, but the golfer incurs a <u>2</u> stroke penalty. The other playing partners should agree on the correct action to be taken if a ball is to be repositioned.
