DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES

Oct. 5 <u>Waterchase</u> (Arlington) 817-861-4653; 8951 Creek Run Rd. Take I-30 westbound, past the Rangers Ballpark, exit at Eastchase Pkwy., right turn to 2nd traffic light. (John T. White Rd.) Turn right for 1 block. Right turn at Randol Mill Rd., drive ¼ mile, left turn at Creek Run Rd., (alongside apt. complex), course ½ mile on left.

Oct. 12 <u>Golf Club of Dallas (Dallas)</u> 214-333-3595; 2200 W. Redbird Ln. From downtown Dallas, drive south on I-35E. Approx 4.4 miles, bear right onto Hwy 67 (towards Cleburne). In approx. 2.2 miles, exit at Hampton Rd. Turn left (under Hwy 67). At 2nd traffic light (Red Bird Ln.) turn left, course entrance .1 mile on right.

Oct. 19 <u>Frisco Lakes</u> (Frisco) 972-292-3089; 899 Rose Lane. Take the Dallas No. Tollway north of Sam Rayburn Tollway (Hwy 121), exit at Stonebrook Pkwy, turn left (west) for approx. 4 miles. Drive straight across Main St. (Hwy 423) and drive another 1.2 miles. Turn left at golf course sign, entrance ¹/₄ mile on left.

Oct. 26 <u>Heritage Ranch</u> (Fairview) 972-549-0276; 465 Scenic Ranch Circle. Take US-75 (Central Expwy) north, exit at Stacy Rd., right turn (east) 3 miles to the dead end (FM 1378). Turn left, then an immediate right, back onto Stacy Rd. Continue east for ½ mile, course entrance on left (gated community with guard shack).

Nov. 2 <u>Grapevine</u> (Grapevine) 817-410-3377; Drive west on LBJ freeway (I-635) towards DFW airport. Prior to the airport entry, exit at Bass Pro Dr., continue to the traffic light. Turn left, drive over Hwy 121, past the Embassy Suites Hotel to the next traffic light (Hwy 26). Turn left, drive ½ mile to next traffic light, turn right (Fairway Dr.) Drive past Cowboys Golf Club and over the Lake Grapevine Dam. On the other side of the Dam, turn right into golf course entrance.

NTSGA adheres to USGA golf rules with some small alterations to allow for more enjoyment for senior golfers. Practice chipping/pitching between holes when participating in a stroke play tournament is not allowed. (USGA Rule 5.3b). You may make practice putting strokes on the hole just completed, providing you are not delaying play for the foursome waiting to hit their approach shots. With 128 golfers participating in our events, you'll probably be holding up the next group during our tournament by delaying on the previous green. Practice putting during a round may also occur on a <u>practice</u> putting green when the green is located between two regulation holes, example, perhaps between Holes 9 and 10, however, again we ask you not to do this in the interest of keeping play moving to finish the round without undue delay.
