DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES

Aug. 2 <u>Mansfield National</u> (Mansfield) 817-477-3366; 3750 National Pkwy. Take I-20 westbound, exit at Hwy 360. Drive south approximately 8 miles. Exit at Heritage Pkwy. At the traffic light, turn left. Course straight ahead.

Aug. 9 <u>Waterchase</u> (Arlington) 817-861-4653; 8951 Creek Run Rd. Take I-30 westbound, past the Rangers Ballpark and Cowboys stadium locations. Exit at Eastchase Pkwy., right turn to 2nd traffic light. (John T. White Rd.) Turn right for 1 block. Right turn at Randol Mill Rd., drive ¼ mile, left turn at Creek Run Rd., (alongside apt. complex), course ½ mile on left.

Aug. 16 <u>Texas Star</u> (Euless) 817-685-7888; 1400 Texas Star Pkwy. Take Hwy 183 (Airport Frwy) west, past the south entrance to DFW Airport. Exit at Hwy 10 West (it becomes Euless Blvd.) Continue on Hwy 10, passing Hwy 157 (Industrial Blvd.) for 1 more mile. Course entrance on left.

Aug. 23 Sky Creek Ranch (Keller) 817-498-1414; 600 Promontory Dr. Drive LBJ Frwy towards DFW Airport, take Hwy 121 south (it goes south for ½ mile, and then turns west). At the Hwy 121/114 split, bear right towards Bridgeport, exit at Southlake Blvd. Turn left, drive 4.9 miles. Left turn at Randol Mill (Dunkin' Donuts on left, Shell station on right). Randol Mill turns into Davis Blvd in a few blocks. Drive .9 miles to 2nd traffic light. Right turn at Bear Creek Pkwy. Drive 1.4 miles through residential area. Watch for small sign to Sky Creek Ranch. Right turn at Promontory Dr., leads to club.

Aug. 30 <u>Plantation</u> (Frisco) 972-335-4653, 4701 Plantation Lane. Drive to the Sam Rayburn Tollway (Hwy 121). Exit at Coit Rd., turn north for ¼ mile. Left turn at Lebanon, course entrance ¾ miles on right.

2-MAN TEAMS: It is the responsibility of the Captain to check off (\checkmark,x) all listed partners for the tournament and pay the entry fee (\$2.00/team). If a partner does not show up for that event and the fee has been paid, that team will be carried over until the next tournament (highlighted in yellow on the computer sign up pages). If a Captain wants to play with a partner that is not on his list, enter the team on the manual sign up page and pay the \$2.00 entry fee.

If a member does not want to be a Captain, simply tell 2-man Team Coordinator, **Jack Whitling** and his name will be removed from the Captain's listing.

2023 OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP POT

The 2023 Open Championship was played in Hoylake, England at Royal Liverpool. This is the 13th time the Open Championship has been played on this golf course. Ninety three selections were made by NTSGA golfers in this years final major Pot, selecting two man combos in hopes of having the right selection to win the last major championship of the year. The most popular selections were pro's playing well over the last several months including Jon Rahm, Rory McIlroy,



Tommy Fleetwood, Scottie Scheffler, Cam Smith and Brooks Koepka. Better weather conditions for the early tee times greeted the golfers, but afternoon tee times had to play in a stiff wind. The pot bunkers throughout the course, severly affected the scores of many golfers as the bunkers sometimes cost the pro's 2 and 3 shots. Fan favorite, Englishman Tommy Fleetwood shared the opening round lead with Emiliano Grillo and amateur Christo Lamprecht. Lamprecht is the first amateur in 12 years to share an opening round lead in a major tournament.

Out of nowhere in Round 2 came Brian Harman, who hasn't won a golf tournament in 6 years and only 2 tournaments during his 12 years on tour. He made four straight birdies and an eagle on 18 that thrust him into the lead, 5 shots ahead of the next competitor, Tommy Fleetwood. Fleetwood was the favorite selection of 17 picks made by NTSGA golfers, however, Brian Harman was not picked by any member to win this year's Open Championship. Dropping out of the tournament after missing the cut were NTSGA favorites...Colin Morikawa, Tony Finau, Justin Rose, Justin Thomas and Dustin Johnson. This also knocked out 21 selections made by NTSGA golfers.

Brian Harman continued to play superb golf during Round 3, dispite a sparkling 63 by Jon Rahm, the lowest score recorded on this golf course in British Open history. Excitement was building in the households of NTSGA members **Bruce Mayberry**, **Chris Arenas**, **Gene Edmondson**, **Frank Arnold** and **Mike Brown** as they had combo selections near the top of the leaderboard.

Round 4 would be played under testing weather conditions as rain and wind were forecast. No one could catch Brian Harman...who saw that coming? The 12 year journeyman turned back all challengers and won the Open Championship by six strokes. He is the second oldest first time major winner in history to raise the Claret jug. The winner of the NTSGA Open Championship Pot was **Frank Arnold**. Jon Rahm (T2) and Tom Kim (T2): \$279.00. 2nd place tie: **Frank Arnold**, **Bruce Mayberry**, **Russ Medlin** and **Jim Staron**: All selected Jon Rahm (T2) and Rory McIlroy (6): \$47.00 each. The next NTSGA Pot wil be the Masters in April 2024.
