DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES

Mar. 1 <u>Waterchase</u> (Arlington) 817-861-4653; 8951 Creek Run Rd. Take I-30 westbound, past the Rangers Ballpark and Cowboys stadium locations. Exit at Eastchase Pkwy., right turn to 2nd traffic light. (John T. White Rd.) Turn right for 1 block. Right turn at Randol Mill Rd., drive ¼ mile, left turn at Creek Run Rd., (alongside apt. complex), course ½ mile on left.

Mar. 8 <u>Waterview</u> (Rowlett) 972-463-8900; 9509 Waterview Pkwy. Drive the Geo. Bush Turnpike east through Garland, past hwy 78/past the Firewheel Mall. Exit at Merritt/Liberty Grove Connector. At <u>2nd</u> stop sign (Liberty Grove), turn left. Drive 1.7 miles. Turn left at Waterview Pkwy, leads to golf course on left. If driving through downtown Dallas on I-30, proceed east of LBJ Frwy (635), Garland, and exit at Geo Bush Turnpike (north). Exit the Turnpike at Lakeview Pkwy/Main St. /Hwy 66. Stay on the Service Road, passing Main St., passing Hwy 66 for another 1.4 miles. Turn right at the stop sign (Liberty Grove). Drive 1.7 miles. Turn left at Waterview Pkwy, leads to golf course on left.

Mar. 15 <u>Luna Vista</u> (Dallas) 214-670-6322; 11223 Luna Rd. Drive to I-35E (Stemmons Frwy). Exit at Royal Lane. Drive west 1.1 miles (traffic light). Turn left (Luna Rd.), drive .4 mile, course entrance on right.

Mar. 22 <u>Bridlewood</u> (Flower Mound) 972-355-4800; 4000 W. Windsor Dr. Proceed north on I-35E, exit at FM1171/Main St. (Lewisville). Turn left (west), drive 5 ½ miles, right turn at Bridlewood Blvd. At 1st stop sign, turn right, course entrance on left.

Mar. 29 <u>Buffalo Creek</u> (Heath) 972-771-4003; 624 Country Club Dr. Drive the George Bush Turnpike east/south (it ends at I-30). Merge onto I-30 <u>east</u>. Go across lake, exit at Horizon Rd. Turn right, drive across Ridge Rd. (traffic light). Immediately past hospital, turn right onto Tubbs Rd. (7-11 store on left). Road changes name to White Rd. as it winds through residential area paralleling golf course. At the stop sign (Country Club Rd.) turn left. Drive ½ mile, course entrance on right.

CREDIT CARDS...

Webmaster **Howie Bacharach** has written a computer program that now allows you the use of credit cards to pay for your round before arriving at our tournament courses. "Express Check In" is available for members and guests on the Next Round tab of our website. Sign-up the regular way and when you are assured of playing, use the Next Round tab and click on Express Check In (yellow). Try to do this at least the day before the round so **Tournament Chairman Rod Wells** and **Treasurer Terry Bell** get the word in time for check-in. You'll be prompted for your member password (first four characters of your last name in lower case followed by mmdd of your birthday). NOTE: guest birthdays are probably not in our system to establish your password. Forward that information to Webmaster **Howie Bacharach** at howardbacharach@gmail.com for password setup.

Members can pay out of their NTSGA member Bank Account if they have sufficient funds. Otherwise choose Electronic Payment (credit or debit card, Google Pay or Square Pay if by PC desktop, Apple Pay if by iPad or iPhone) or PayPal. When payment is complete you will see a confirmation page and also receive an email. No other check-in will be required at the course, other than paying for skins and 2-man team competition, if desired. NOTE: a service fee is added (\$2.10 for Square electronic payment, \$2.68 for PayPal) since that is what the service companies charge us to handle the transactions.

There is a box to check if you don't have to pay a greens fee (ex. marshall or club member)...give the page a second to settle after it loads, then check the box. You will see the amount due correctly reflect the \$10.00 prize fee for members or zero for guests. If that doesn't change when you check the box, uncheck and re-check to try again.

If you have to cancel or are otherwise unable to play, you will be refunded to your payment method.

Everything is handled on the Square and PayPal servers, so it is fully encrypted and secure. If payment was successful, you will show "checked in" on the signup list (Signup > Next Round Signup Lists).
