## **DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES...**

Jan. 17 <u>Buffalo Creek</u> (Rockwall) 972-771-4003; 624 Country Club Dr. Drive the George Bush Turnpike east/south (it ends at I-30). Merge onto I-30 <u>east</u>. Go across lake, exit at Horizon Rd. Turn right, drive across Ridge Rd. (traffic light). Immediately past hospital, turn right onto Tubbs Rd. (7-11 store on left). Road changes name to White Rd. as it winds through residential area paralleling golf course. At the stop sign (Country Club Rd.) turn left. Drive ¼ mile, course entrance on right.

Jan. 24 <u>Watters Creek (Allen)</u> 972-517-7777; 7201 Chase Oaks Blvd. Drive I-75 (Central Expwy). Exit at Legacy Dr., turn west. At 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light, (Chase Oaks Blvd) turn right. Course ½ mile on left.

Jan. 31 <u>Tangleridge</u> (Grand Prairie) 972-299-6837; 818 Tangle Ridge Dr. Take I-35E south thru downtown Dallas. Bear right at the Hwy 67 split, towards Cleburne. After passing under I-20, drive 8.7 miles, exit at Lake Ridge Pkwy., right turn, drive 2 miles. Turn left at Park Ridge Dr. (traffic light), follow signs through residential area for approx. 1.2 miles to golf course entrance. Or, drive south on the George Bush Turnpike through Arlington towards I-20. Exit at Lake Ridge Parkway (the exit before I-20) and continue south for approx 8.5 miles. After crossing <u>2<sup>nd</sup></u> bridge, drive .8 mile turning right at the traffic light to enter the Tangleridge residential area. Drive approx. 1.2 miles (go past elementary school). Turn right at Park Ridge Ct. Leads to golf course.

## HOLE-IN-ONE: GEORGE MILLER...


Fifteen year NTSGA member George Miller recorded the Association's fifth Hole-In-One of 2023 on Dec. 6<sup>th</sup>. It was George's first ever hole-in-one! Witnessed by playing

partners President Roger Ball and Scott Daum, George hit his 9 iron exactly 121 yards into the 11<sup>th</sup> hole at Pecan Hollow. It is the only hole-in-one ever recorded on this hole by an NTSGA member during tournament play. George grew up in a farming community in southwest Oklahoma. Following high school, George graduated from East Central University in Ada, Oklahoma. After graduation,

George served his country by fulfilling a 2 year military obligation in the U.S. Navy. He served on the Admirals staff aboard the USS Klondike and USS Jason, home ported in San Diego. Following George's Navy service, he returned to the greater Dallas area and became a middle school/high school educator for 53 years. His lengthy school affiliations allowed him to teach in and out of the classroom, coaching football and basketball at Mesquite High School. In the classroom, George taught classes in Business Law, Math, Typing and American History.

NTSGA will add \$200.00 to George's Bank account, in addition to having gifted watercolor artist, member Wayne Mueller paint a picture for George.



## **CREDIT CARDS:**

You are able to pay for your round by credit card in advance by following the top menu path "<u>Next Round --> Express Check In</u>" from our website (<u>www.ntsga.org</u>). You will be prompted for your Member Password, which is the first four letters of your last name in lower case followed by mmdd of your birthday (ex: hoga0813). Choose "<u>Electronic</u> <u>Payment</u>" to pay by Square (or Apple Pay or Google Pay if you are using your phone or tablet). If you prefer <u>PayPal</u> or <u>Venmo</u>, choose one of those. NOTE: The payment vendor's service fee will be added to your payment - \$2.10 by Square/Apple/Google, \$2.68 by PayPal/Venmo. If you are <u>exempt from green fees</u> at a particular course (ex: marshal or club member), check the box indicating so and you will only be charged for your prize fee. Once you have sufficient funds in your <u>Member Account</u> from winnings, you will also be able to pre-pay for a round from your account balance. You will be notified by e-mail that your Express Check In has been completed. Although you will not have to pay at the tournament, our Tournament Chairman Rod Wells asks that you quickly stop by the check in table to let him now you are there.
