GOLF CARTS:

If the course is wet/muddy the Pro Shop will usually deem that carts must remain on the cart paths at all times (Cart Path Only). If the course superintendent allows us to drive on the course (90 degree rule), carts may drive on the course. There are usually directional signs (30-40 yds. in front of the greens) directing the cart to proceed left or right back to the cart paths, protecting the approach area in front of the greens. Even though sometimes there are no directional signs, common sense and common courtesy dictates not driving close to the greens. Golf carts should NEVER be driven ON the green, or in close proximity TO THE FRONT of any putting surface.

DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES...

Apr. 2 <u>Grapevine</u> (Grapevine) 817-410-3377; Drive west on LBJ freeway (I-635) towards DFW airport. Prior to the airport entry, exit at Bass Pro Dr., continue to the traffic light. Turn left, drive over Hwy 121, past the Embassy Suites Hotel to the next traffic light (Hwy 26). Turn left, drive ½ mile to next traffic light, turn right (Fairway Dr.) Drive past Cowboys Golf Club and over the Lake Grapevine Dam. On the other side of the Dam, turn right into golf course entrance.

Apr. 9 <u>Tierra Verde</u> (Arlington) 817-478-8500; 7005 Golf Club Dr. Take I-20 west past Hwy 360, turn south on Hwy 287 towards Mansfield for approx. 2½ miles, exit at Eden Road (2nd exit south of I-20). At stop sign turn right for ½ mile. Left turn at entrance to Martin Luther King Sports Center. Second driveway on left leads into clubhouse.

Apr. 16 <u>Tenison-Highlands</u> (Dallas) 214-670-1402; 3501 Samuell Blvd. Drive east of downtown Dallas on I-30, exit at Dolphin Rd., turn left , under I-30 for 1 block, right turn on Samuell Blvd. Then a left turn at Tenison Parkway, course entrance on right.

Apr. 30 <u>The Bridges</u> (Gunter, TX) 903-696-0022; 2400 Fred Couples Dr. Drive I-75 north. Exit at <u>FM</u>121 (Van Alstyne – Exit #51). Turn left (west) Drive 7.4 miles. Course entrance on left, follow signs to clubhouse OR from the Geo. Bush Freeway & Preston Rd. (Hwy 289) drive north on Preston Road thru Prosper, thru Celina to Gunter (32 miles). Turn right on Main St. (the road makes a couple 90 degree turns). Golf Course entrance is on the right, drive to clubhouse.
