DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSES:

Nov. 5 <u>Waterchase</u> (Arlington) 817-861-4653; 8951 Creek Run Rd. Take I-30 westbound, past the Rangers Ballpark and Cowboys stadium locations. Exit at Eastchase Pkwy., right turn to 2nd traffic light. (John T. White Rd.) Turn right for 1 block. Right turn at Randol Mill Rd., drive ¼ mile, left turn at Creek Run Rd., (alongside apt. complex), course ½ mile on left.

Nov. 12 <u>Tierra Verde</u> (Arlington) 817-478-8500; 7005 Golf Club Dr. Take I-20 west past Hwy 360, turn south on Hwy 287 towards Mansfield for approx. 2½ miles, exit at Eden Road (2nd exit south of I-20). At stop sign turn right for ½ mile. Left turn at entrance to Martin Luther King Sports Center. Second driveway on left leads into clubhouse.

Nov. 19 <u>Sherrill Park</u> (Richardson) 972-234-1416; 2001 E. Lookout Dr. Take Geo. Bush Turnpike east of Central Expwy. Turn south at Jupiter for approx. 1 mile, right turn at E. Lookout Drive, golf course straight ahead.

Dec. 3 <u>Pecan Hollow</u> (Plano) 972-941-7600; 4501 E. 14th St. Drive the Geo. Bush Turnpike, exit east of Central Expy (I-75) at Jupiter. Drive north for 1 mile, turn right on 14th street and drive 2.3 miles. Course entrance on left. (Careful of oncoming traffic).

Dec. 10 <u>Texas Star</u> (Euless) 817-685-7888; 1400 Texas Star Pkwy. Take Hwy 183 (Airport Frwy) west, past the south entrance to DFW Airport. Exit at Hwy 10 West (it becomes Euless Blvd.) Continue on Hwy 10, passing Hwy 157 (Industrial Blvd.) for 1 more mile. Course entrance on left.

SIGN-UP REVIEW...


When members sign-up for a tournament and then don't show up, it creates problems for Tournament Chairman Rod Wells. He has to juggle pairings, adjust the totals with the Pro Shop and move members from cart to cart prior to commencing play. All time-consuming requirements. Please review NTSGA By-Laws Article VI, Section 4: Tournament Sign-Up Policy. Email and telephone sign-ups start at 8:00AM, 8 days prior to an event and stop at 12:00 noon, 2 days before an event. Players who sign-up and fail to show-up will incur a 2-event suspension. This suspension can be prevented by notifying the Tournament Chairman (214-629-6707) prior to 12:00 noon, the day before the event. After 3 sign-up/no-shows a players' NTSGA membership will be terminated. The sign-in table at tournament sites will close 30 minutes prior to tee time and no more registrations will be accepted. At this time the Tournament Chairman will assign vacant pairing spots to alternate golfers who have come to the golf course hoping to play.
